                                 3rd nine– Captain's Choice

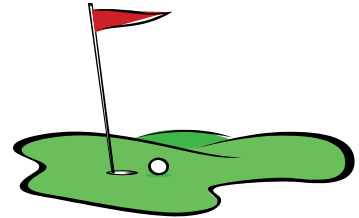
Each 2– Person team will be given a handicap for each format.

### **Fees:**

## Superintendents Report

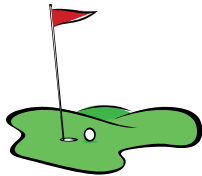


Spring is here and the course is greening up.

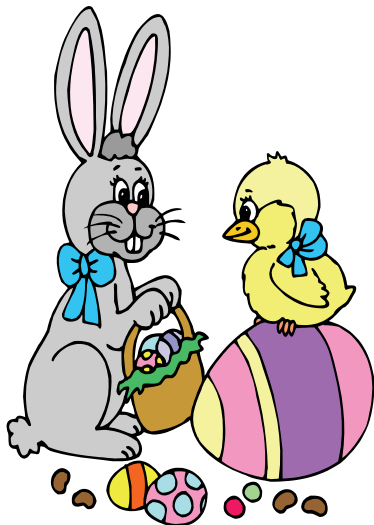

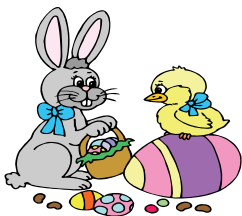
