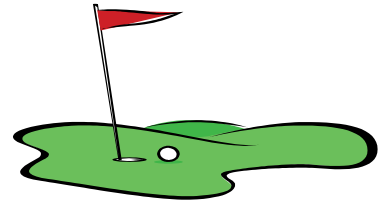
Super Bowl Scramble Sunday, February 5, 2012 1:00 P.M. Shotgun Start

All proceeds will go to Judy's expenses while she is going thru some tough health issues.

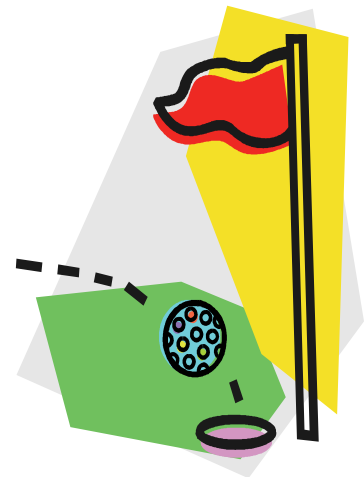

Superintendents Report

It was good to see everyone at the annual meeting. It looked like we had a good turnout.

Over the next several weeks certain holes on the course could be cart path only more than normal. Chemical applications, rain, and frozen ground will determine when the course is cart path only. We have received several inches of rain recently. This is great news for the ponds, but there are several saturated areas on the course. Please try to keep carts on the cart paths as much as possible around these wet areas and around greens.

In early January we applied the last coat of paint on the greens. We have also started spraying for winter weeds. Over the next several weeks you should start to see these weeds yellow and die.

We still need a little more money to buy the materials to renovate a bunker. If you would like to donate any money toward the Don Cushway fund please see Katie.

Again, if an area is wet, please keep carts away from those areas. The turf will not recover in the wintertime from excessive cart traffic.

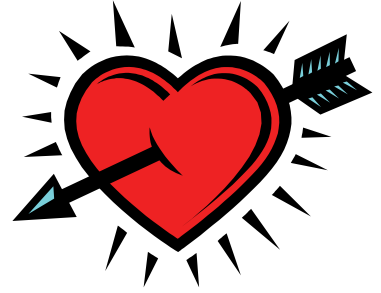
There will be 2 and 4 person tables available this year,
