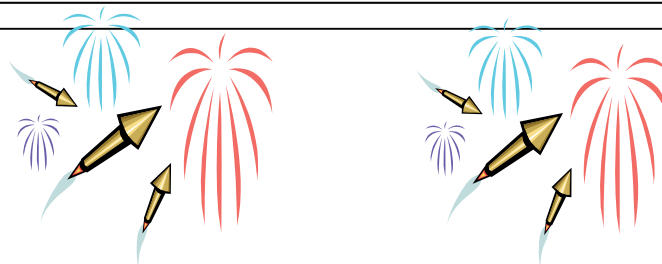

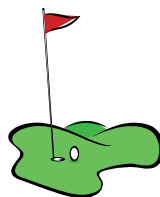


Don Cushway Memorial Fund

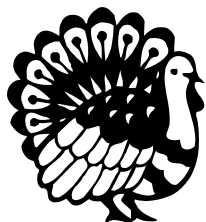
