We have had a cold start to spring this year. Maybe in the next few weeks we will warm up and the grass will start to green up. We continue to receive plenty of rain. Please avoid the low lying areas on the creek holes.

We are going to continue to work in flower beds while we have time during this cold weather. Thanks to Bud West and his crew for coming out last week and cutting down some of the large dead pine trees on the course and his mechanic for fixing the tractor. Bud saved the club a considerable amount of money.

This time of year ball marks become problematic on greens. Please fix your ball marks the correct way. The following link is a good resource for the correct way to fix a ball mark:

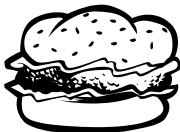

Don't forget about the adopt a hole program. We still have holes available. Please contact me or Katie to adopt your hole.

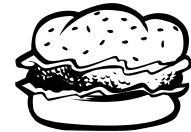
