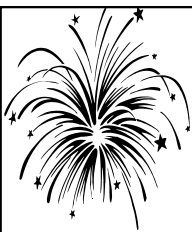

Rule of the Month



I've recently had questions about sprinkler heads on the course. Sprinkler heads should be treated as immovable obstructions and located in rule 24-2. This rule states that an immovable obstruction is an artificial object on the course that cannot be moved or readily moved. This object must physically interfere with your lie of the ball, your stance or your swing. If any interference occurs you may drop your ball within one club length of the nearest point of relief no closer to the hole. Just remember this rule next time your ball comes to rest around a sprinkler head and it is in your way of your next shot!

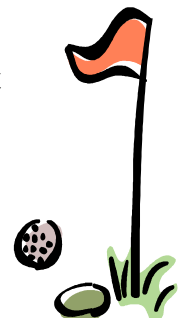

The Saga of a High Handicapper

Seven years ago when my wife Lori & I joined CCN and I didn't really understand what a handicap in golf was all about. I thought a golf handicap didn't apply to me since I was a very poor golfer. The CCN Senior's Group quickly clued me in (I think they just wanted to win my money!). However, I very quickly discovered the handicap is the **Great Equalizer!!!**

For example: if you shoot a high average score of say 95 (unfortunately mine is usually higher) your handicap is 23 and is calculated by a Gross Score of 95 less Par 72 and that is what gets used in Tournaments! You get to subtract 23 from your score. How great is that?

So no matter how poor you golf, you can be competitive in tournaments by using the golf handicap system. In fact, in many cases it is more likely for a high handicapper to have a good net round, than a person with a low handicap. So don't let poor play hold you back. Get in the handicap system (in the Pro Shop) and play in some tournaments. The best part is you meet new people, enjoy a game of golf, have fun and every once in awhile you can win.

After seven years with a handicap and playing in tournaments, I am enjoying more golf and I am a less poor golfer....however maybe I should see Brian for some lessons.

Bye for now from the High Handicapper.

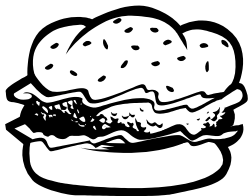

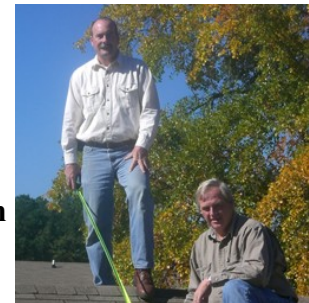
