Superintendents Report

Please be patient as we try to keep the course clear of leaves and debris. The leaves are continuing to fall and we are working hard to keep the playing surfaces clear.

Please continue to fix ball marks on greens. In the winter months ball marks on Bermuda greens do not heal, so fixing your ball marks the correct way will keep the putting surface in better shape.

In the winter months we change pin placements once a week with the exception of some tournaments where the pins could get changed more often. This is to eliminate chopping up the putting surface with old pin placements. In the summer time this is not a problem because the old pin placements have time to heal. These plugs do not heal in the winter time and can make our greens uneven and bumpy.

Sand containers were placed on the par three tees. Please use this sand to fill your divots and any other divots you see.

As winter approaches, be prepared for frost delays.

Traffic on frozen turf can damage the plant, and hinder green-up in the spring. On frosty mornings, tee times will be delayed and carts will be kept on the paths.
