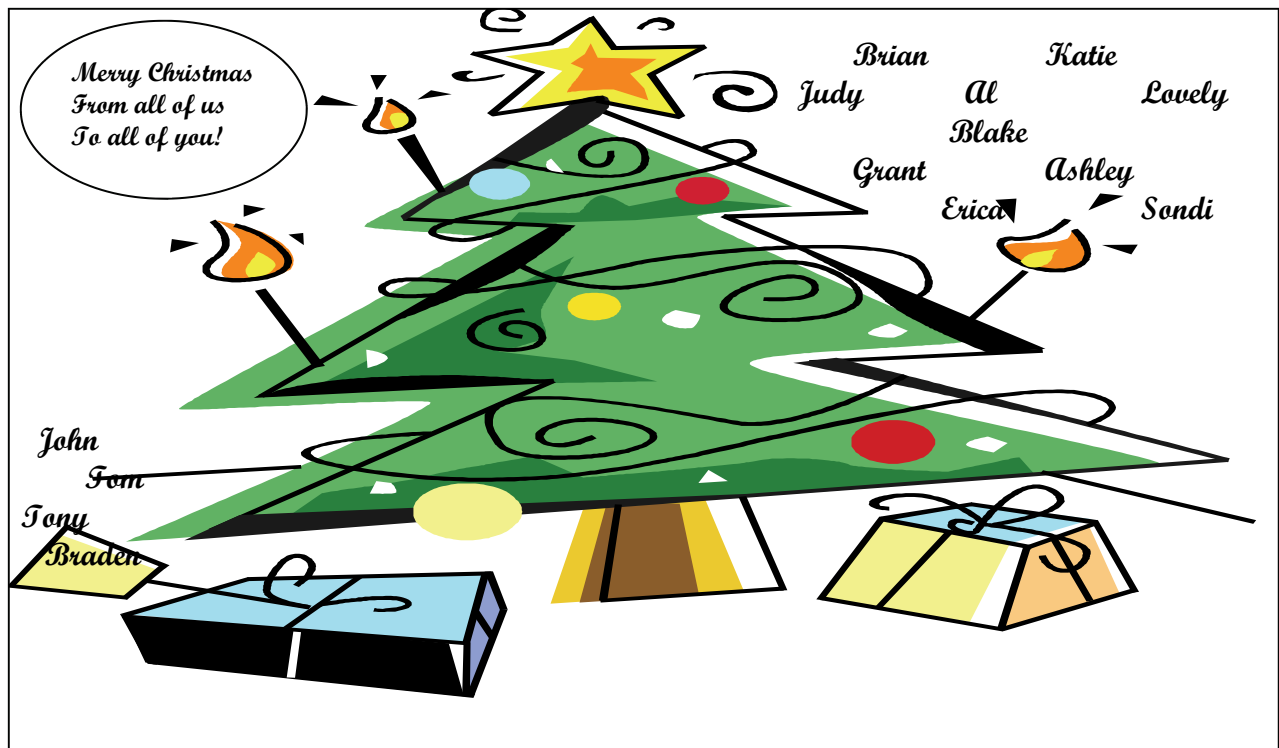

## Superintendents Report

I hope everyone had a good Thanksgiving.

It was good to see everyone who participated in the Clemson/Carolina tournament. The tournament turned out much better than the actual game for us Tiger fans. I hope the oysters were cooked to perfection.

It looks like it has finally started to rain. We received an over an inch of rain last week and, it looks like the trend is going to continue this week. The ponds will be full again before we know it.

I mentioned frost delays in my last report. Please remember that frost and freeze delays will determine the first tee time over the next few months. Frost delays are possible when the temperature falls into the upper 30's or below. Foot and cart traffic can damage frozen or frosty turf. The effects of this damage may not be visible until spring green up. Soil temperatures, direct sunlight, and air temperatures determine the length of the delay. As air temperatures get cooler, we can expect longer delays.

Just about enough money has been raised through the Don Cushway fund to buy sand to renovate a bunker. The right-greenside bunker on number eleven will be the first renovation project. Over the next several months, we will hopefully raise enough money to renovate a couple more.

In December, we will be painting the railings and the columns around the clubhouse, weather permitting. If anyone has a ladder tall enough to reach the 20-foot plus columns please let me know.

Please continue to follow the cart signs and ropes around the course. The turf will not recover in the wintertime from excessive cart traffic.

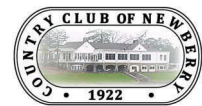


## Points from the Pro-Shop
