2014 END OF YEAR CCN RECAP by Dennis Leslie

Since my Mid-Year Update in the June CCN Newsletter, the Management Team, the Board, Staff and I have continued to work hard on increasing club revenue. In addition to our expanded marketing efforts noted in June, Brian Summer assisted by Scott Meetze has brought in additional tournaments, both outside as well as club events. Chuck Wideman, our Superintendent, and his staff have worked very hard to have the course in the best shape in years which helps to draw outside play and tournaments. Our Office Manager/Secretary/Treasurer-Katie Stevens has very aggressively pursued rentals for the Clubhouse facilities-which are 20% above plan. In addition our Pro Shop, Snack Bar and House Keeping Staff have done a great job in taking care of our Members and Guests.

These efforts along with very aggressive expense control have helped offset the heavy losses (more than twice normal) that occurred in the first three months of the year due to excessive rain, snow, sleet and poor weather. As you may recall, the Club was completely shut 18 out of 90 days that is equivalent to 20% of the time, plus there was very limited play during the Winter Months due to poor weather conditions.

I think you will be glad to know that in spite of the very poor first quarter with the above mentioned efforts, we have decreased our loss to a relatively small amount, AS A RESULT WE WILL NOT BE HAVING AN INCREASE IN DUES AND WE WILL NOT BE HAVING A ONE-TIME FEE FOR 2015. We will continue our best efforts to control costs and increase revenue. However, we continue to need the help of CCN Members...continue to play...play more...bring friends and family with you...help us to spot potential new members. Remember if you bring us a new member you will get one month of free dues.

Finally, though there is no dues increase or one-time fee to vote on, we do have two open Board Positions to elect and to vote on the President's Position. So please mark your calendars for Tuesday, January 20th to come to the Annual Meeting to vote for these positions. If you cannot attend please send your proxies with your vote to insure that we have a quorum.

Thank you for your participation and support and look forward to seeing you all at the Annual Meeting.

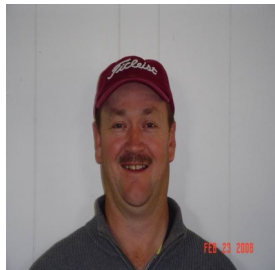

If you are interested in running for any of these positions please let us know so that we can run it in the next newsletter. At the time of this printing we have the following that have announced to run for board or president.

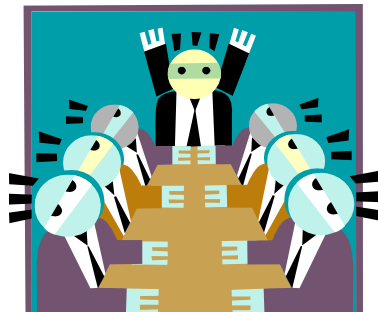
Dennis Leslie & Jamie Peake are running for the President's position.

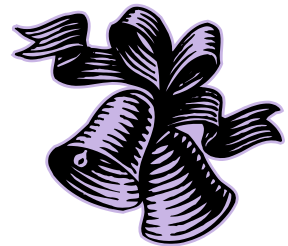

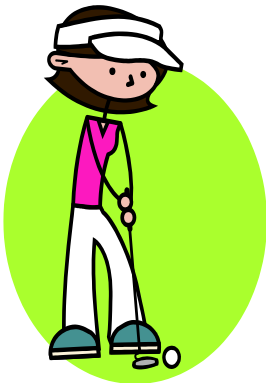

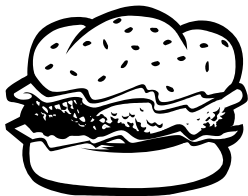
