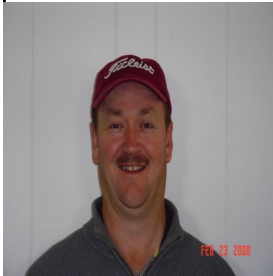

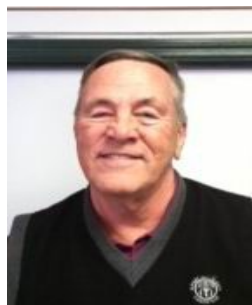

At the annual stockholders meeting Jan.21, 2014 the membership voted to increase the monthly dues to \$120.00 for single memberships and \$125.00 for a family membership. This increase comes with a membership receiving free range balls and a \$10.00 per month credit in the snack bar. Range balls will be on the driving range daily for your use. Non members will still be charged in the Pro Shop for range balls.

The credit in the snack bar will be handled as follows:

- \* Each single or family member will have a \$10.00 credit beginning the first day of each month and any credit remaining will expire the last day of the month. No money will be carried over to the next month.
- \* The \$10.00 credit will be under the stockholders membership number. You must tell the snack bar attendant your membership number to use your credit. You will be asked to initial a receipt at the time of purchase. This is for the office to track the credits used.
- \* No cash back for credits, the credit can not be transferred or used by another person.
- \* Disabled members and Junior members will only get free range balls.

Any member that has already paid for the yearly range has been issued a credit that will apply to the difference in the dues increase.

Any member that has already paid their dues for the year will need to pay the difference for 10 months to clear the entire year.

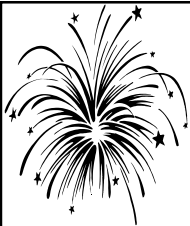
These changes will be in effect February 1, 2014. We hope to be able to offer you more and improved options in the snack bar in the coming months.

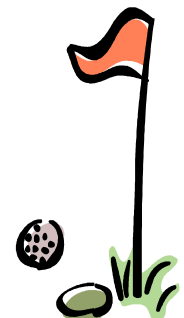
### Rule of the Month

So remember this rule when a gust of wind moves your ball.

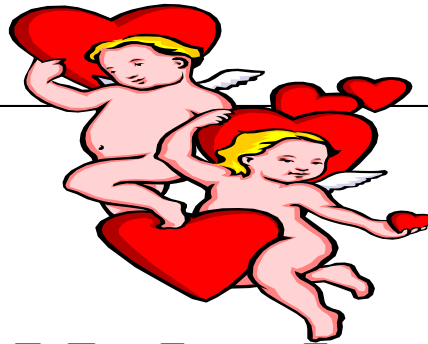

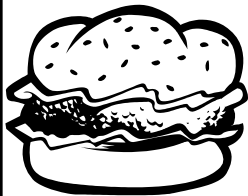

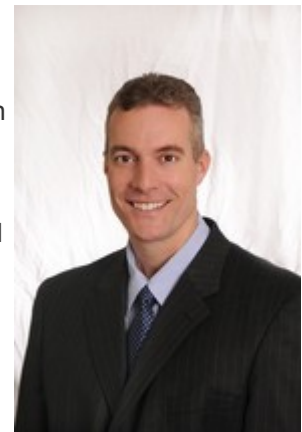
