Superintendents Report

I hope everyone had a great Christmas and enjoyed the time off to spend with family.

We have had plenty of rain in the past week. As you know most of our bunkers hold water. The only way to fix a bunker that holds water is to renovate the bunker. We do have a small pump that was bought to pump the bunkers that hold water for longer periods of time. We do not have the ability or staff to pump all the bunkers that hold water after every rain. Please be patient as some bunkers will have standing water for several days after heavy rains.

Over the next couple of months we will be spraying the course for winter and summer weed control. Please be aware that some days the front nine or back nine may be closed for short periods while herbicides are applied.

I have noticed an increase in cart traffic around greens and tees. Cart traffic will damage the turf and makes an undesirable playing surface. Please, stay on the cart path around tees and greens.

Please continue to fix ball marks on greens. In the winter months ball marks on Bermuda greens do not heal, so fixing your ball marks the correct way will keep the putting surface in better shape.

Sand containers were placed on the par three tees. Please use this sand to fill your divots and any other divots you see.

Winter is here and frost delays will become more prevalent. Traffic on frozen turf can damage the plant, and hinder green-up in the spring. On frosty mornings, tee times will be delayed and carts will be kept on the paths.
