President's Mid-Year Update

Membership continues to decline at CCN. Our membership has dropped from 198 in January to the current level of 189. The Board implemented the one month trial membership program with some positive signs of increased new membership. The club administration continues to cut costs without negatively impacting the daily operations. The superintendent continues to maintain the course in excellent condition with budgetary limitations.

The Board approved replacement of the irrigation pump and has constructed a new pump-house. The overall project is possible through donations of equipment and volunteers making possible a project that would cost in excess of 75K. The overall cost for the pump replacement project for the club should be less than 20K. We expect the new irrigation pump to be operational by August.

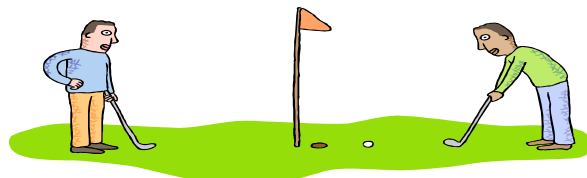

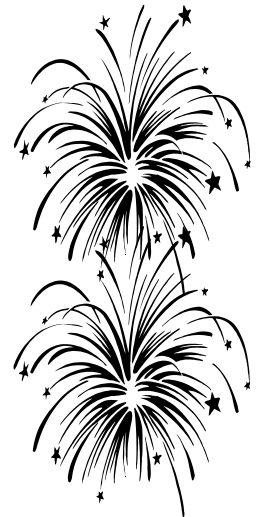

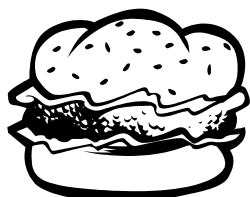

Superintendent's Report

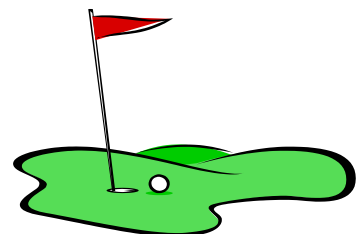
