## Points from the Pro-Shop

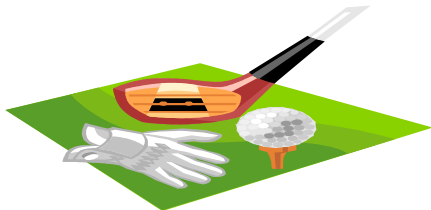

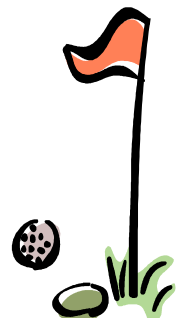


## Superintendent's Report

## Rule of the Month



Rule 27-1 has to do with, when does a provisional ball become a ball in play. I have witnessed this rule not being used properly several times in the past few years. This rule states that a player may play a provisional ball until he reaches the place where the original ball is likely to be. If a stake is made with the provisional ball from the place where the original ball is likely to be or from a point nearer the hole than that place, the original ball is lost and the provisional ball becomes the ball in play.

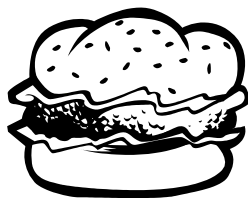
