Notes from the Greens Superintendent

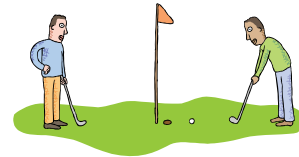
First, I want to thank all the members and the board for a warm welcome over the past couple weeks. For those of you I have not met, I look forward to meeting each of you.

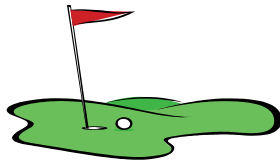
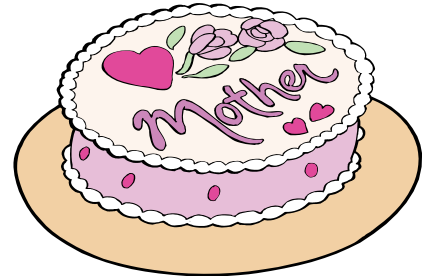

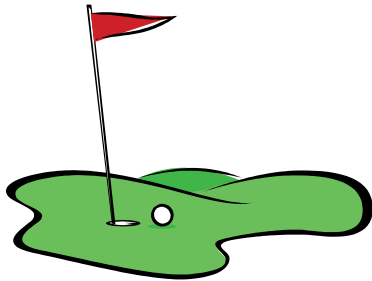
