Rule of the Month Playing wrong ball rule 15-3b

He shall incur a penalty of (2) strokes and must correct his mistake by playing the correct ball. His playing partners incurs no penalty for his ball being played wrongfully and must place a ball on the spot from which the wrong ball was first played. I hope that this explanation will help everyone next time this happens on the course.
