Rule of the Month

This rule should get a lot of use with the amount of rain we have accumulated this spring. This rule has to do with taking relief from casual water. Casual water is any temporary accumulation of water on the course that is not in a water hazard and is visible after the player takes his stance. The player is entitled to lift and

before or after the player takes his stance. The player is entitled to lift and drop the ball without penalty, within one club length of and not nearer the hole than the nearest point of relief. Make sure to use this rule the next time you find your ball in one of our wet areas.
