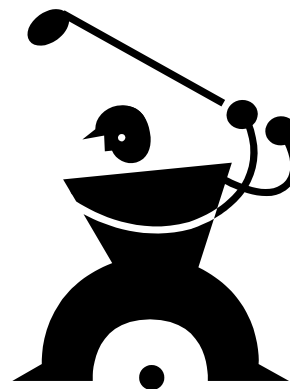

Severe damage can be caused to Bermuda grass by traffic from people or carts when frost is present. The frost delays may vary from day to day to please plan your round accordingly. Check with the Pro Shop before teeing off.
- ◆ Fall is here so be sure to check in the Pro Shop if you need to purchase some new long sleeve apparel. I have a sale currently on all men and women's long sleeve wear. Some items in stock are wind shirts, sweatshirts, mock turtlenecks and rain jackets.

We have had a very dry fall so far this year. We have been over a month without any significant rainfall. With this said, please try to stay on the cart paths as much as possible. Heavy cart traffic will damage the turf and will leave us a poor playing surface in the winter months.

Sand containers were placed on the par three tees. Please use this sand to fill your divots and any other divots you see. We have decided not to overseed the par three tees this year to help with the spring transition and maintenance costs, so please take time to place sand in your divots in order to keep our par three tees in the best shape possible.

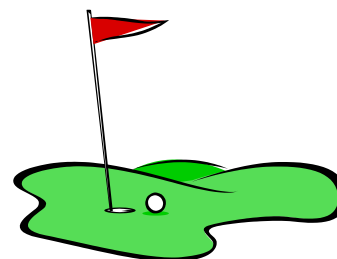

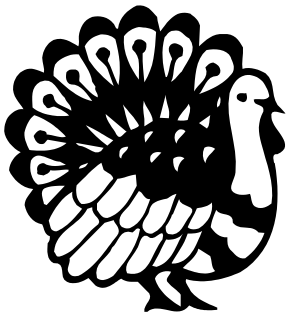
