As many of you know our large irrigation pump is quite old. The expected life of our irrigation style pump is 18-20 years. Our pump is 24 years old! Its ancient, and in the last 4 years the Club has spent approximately \$8,000 in fixing and maintaining it.

Currently, we are investigating a new pump or pump system with three different companies. It is interesting to note that if our existing pump system died it would take a minimum of 3-1/2 weeks to replace with expedited shipping i.e. which would cost another 5-10% more. If it went out in the heat of the summer months, in 3-1/2 weeks there is a strong possibility that we could loose our greens! It is a disaster waiting to happen.

In light of the above, we are having a special golf tournament to raise money to help make a down payment on a new pump system. After prizes, ALL OF THE PROCEEDS will go into a new separate account solely for the purpose of replacing the pump in a timely manner. We are currently researching methods to finance the work. We have named the tournament the ***PUMPALOOZA*** Tournament.

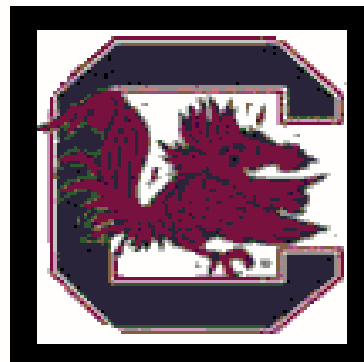

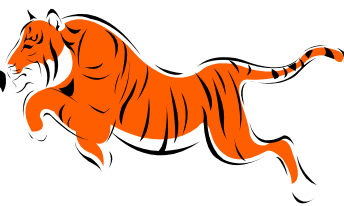

Please remember that proceeds will go to the fund to replace our irrigation pumps.

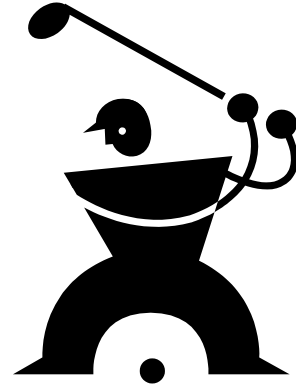

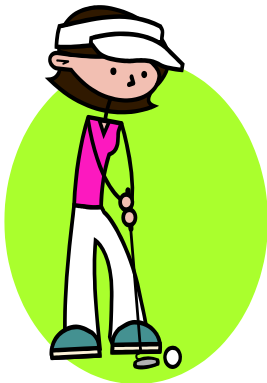

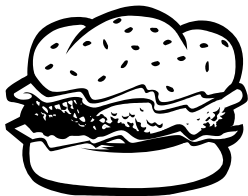
