Before I started writing this month's newsletter I looked back to see what I wrote about last October. Last September we were in one of the worst droughts in 50 years, but it had just rained enough to green everything up. We obviously have not had that problem this year. We have been blessed with plenty of rain this year and the ponds have remained full most of the summer. The rain and warm temperatures have made it challenging keeping up with all the grass. The crew has done a great job this summer, often staying late, to keep everything mowed as often as possible.

Now that cooler weather is here, the grass will start to slow down. This will give us some time to get some other things accomplished. This month we plan start blowing leaves, overseed the driving range tees, pine straw some beds, and cut dead trees on the golf course.

In the fall and winter months the turf heals slowly. Please continue to obey all cart signs. For the next several months stay on the cart paths as much as possible. Please remember to fill all divots and fix all ball marks.
