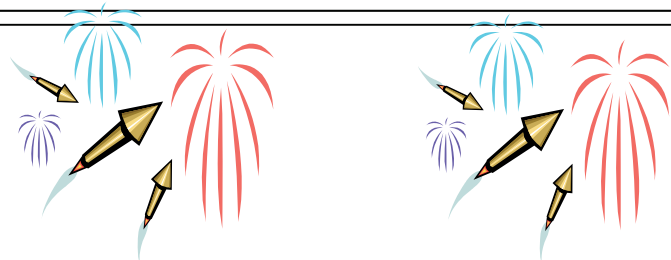

While playing please take the time to thank our golf course maintenance staff. I only have two guys during the week right now, and they are doing a great job keeping up with everything.

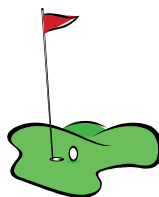


Don Cushway

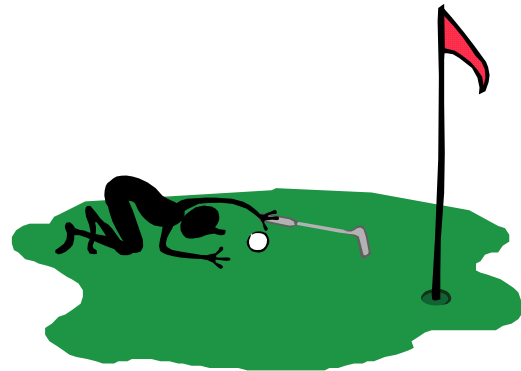
