## Points from the Pro-Shop

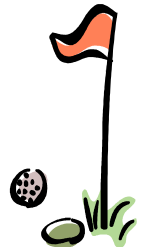

We have presented cards to be on display at local businesses.

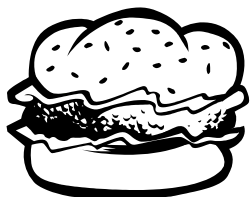
We ran specials on social media. We urge you to like us on Facebook.

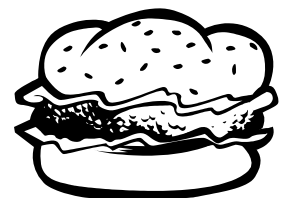
