Food is being cooked to order now so call in your order or allow enough time for your order to be cooked. This is an effort to offer better quality food and service to our membership.

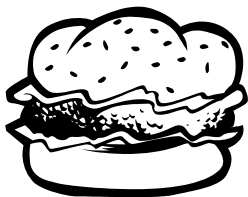
