Mulligans may be used only on the tee box or on the green.

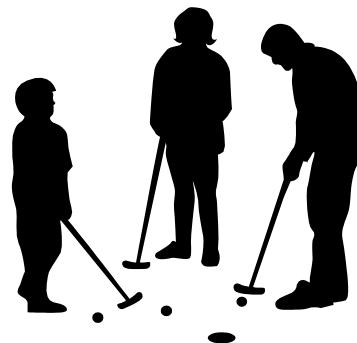
Cash Prizes will be awarded as follows:

Please help keep greens and green surrounds clear of trash. I have noticed cigarette butts and other trash left on greens. Remember to fill divots on tees and fairways. Over the next couple months the grass will start to slow down and will not recover as fast, so help keep our tees and fairways in good shape by filling all your divots and one other divot every shot.

This program would include an individual or group of individuals volunteering their time to beautify flowerbeds, fill divots, repair ball marks, and to assist in keeping the hole in excellent playing condition.
