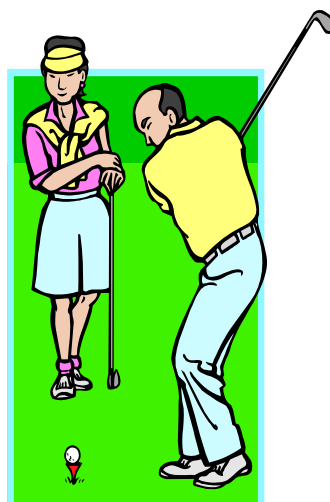

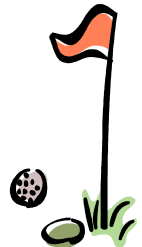
Superintendent's Report

Member rate is \$50.00 per hour, non-members \$75.00 per hour.

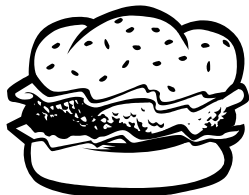

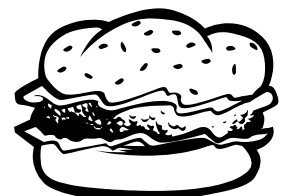
