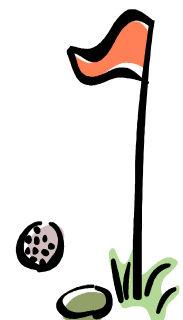


Superintendent's Report

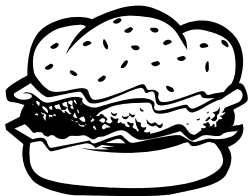
