We have experienced an unusually dry summer at the golf course. In June, we received less than two inches of rain and so far, in July we have had less than an inch. As you can see, our water supply is running out so please pray for rain.

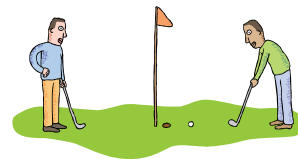
The next greens aerification date has been set for August 8th and 9th, the Monday and Tuesday after Member-Member. The front nine will be closed on the 8th and the back will be closed on the 9th. The holes will take several weeks to fill in, and the greens' speed will decrease for a short period.

Please check with the pro shop if you want to tee off on the back. Early play on the back nine can impede our ability to complete important tasks.

Dry weather alone can damage the turf on the golf course, which makes it even more important to follow the cart traffic signs. Please try to stay on the cart path around greens and only 90 degrees on fairways.

Broken tees on tee boxes can cause problems for our mowers and are unsightly. Help the golf maintenance crew out and pick up your broken tees.

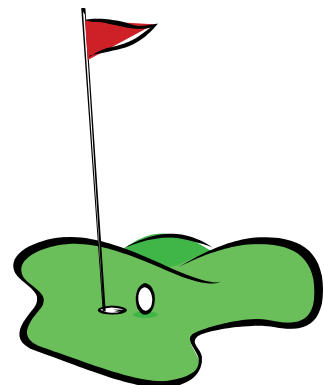
