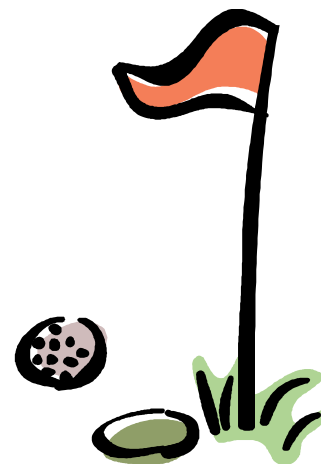

Superintendents Report

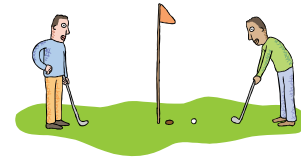
May has been a very productive month for the golf course maintenance staff. Greens aeration was completed on the 16th and 17th, and all greens have been top dressed. The holes are growing in nicely, and we will begin to drop the height of cut. The putting speed will increase over the next several weeks. The tees and fairways have also been fertilized.

In June we will continue to improve the quality of the golf course. We plan to spray weeds on tees and fairways. The herbicides will take several weeks to take effect. Bunker work will also continue throughout the summer.

Please remember to follow the cart direction signs. Cart traffic is a problem around greens, so remember to stay on the cart path around the greens.

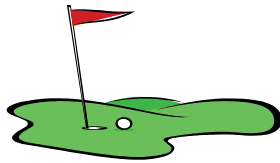

Cart fee of \$13.00 will be taken up for the practice round.

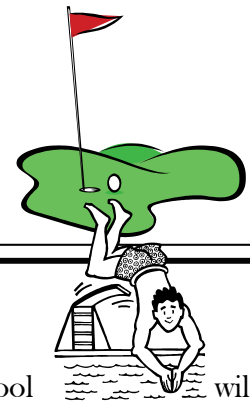
**Requirements: Be an amateur golfer with a verifiable a USGA handicap. Be at least 18 years old. Any player found to give false information may be subject to disqualification.
