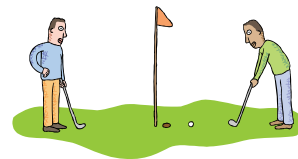
The greens aerification went well. The holes have grown in nicely and greens speeds will begin to increase.

We have decided not to overseed par three tees this year. This will allow us to clean up some of the weeds on these tees this winter. The extreme dry conditions has weakened the turf on these tees. By not overseeding these tees, they should make a better transition out of dormancy next spring. We will be overseeding the driving range tee.

The golf course maintenance staff has been downsized to three guys. Please be patient with us over the next month as we try to keep up with everything.

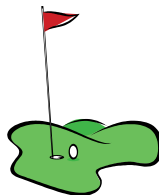
Again, pray for rain!

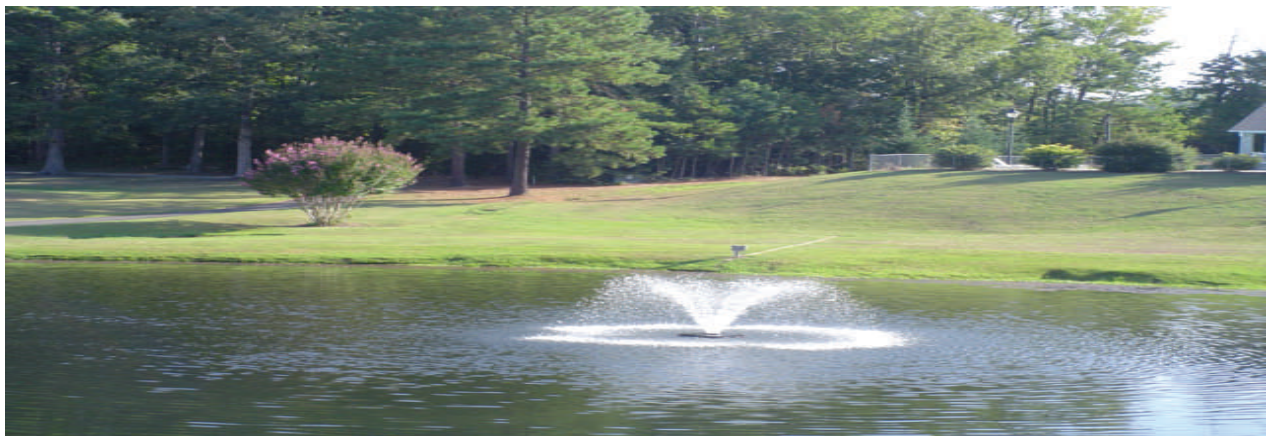
